

Instructor Indemnity Insurance Proposal

Summary of Cover

This policy will meet the demands and needs of someone who wishes to provide protection for costs and damages they may become liable to pay for injury to Third Parties. This may arise out of their instructions, demonstrations or supervision of martial arts activities.

Eligibility

To qualify for cover, applicants must be 18 years of age or over. You must confirm having achieved instructors' certification, Black Belt or another acceptable standard and be an affiliated member of Association of Classical Martial Arts.
